With only the last fortnight of the 2010 DDCA Season remaining, it is a tight tussle at the top of the Leader board for the 2010 Nightcliff CC Cricketer of the Year.

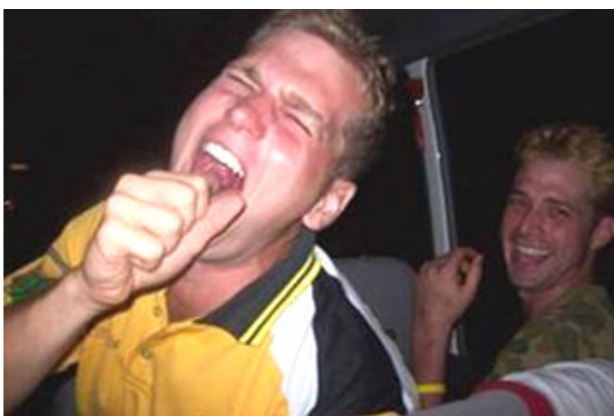
Reigning Champion **Marc “the Incredible Calk” Calkin** is currently leading the table with an impressive **720 points**, on the back of his second successive 500+ A-Grade Season. Marc has to date scored 1,057 runs for Nightcliff in a little under 2 seasons, which does not include the 170-odd runs he has also chalked up like a teacher on Acid in the Twenty-20 stuff!

But right on the *Incredible Calk*'s (Jack) hammer is B-Grade all rounder **Brion “Axel” Foley**, who has just knocked up taking wickets in 2010, with an astonishing 37 scalps to date in 2010.

Nestled in right behind the leading men and poised to strike are a **pair of cagey, cagey Hattons** in the form of **Marky-Mark** and **Brad-man**, who are certainly close enough to take the coveted NCC 2010 Cricketer of the Year with a stellar last two weeks of cricket. E-GRADE

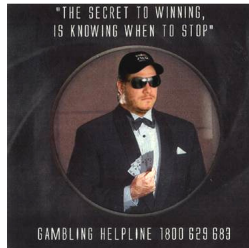

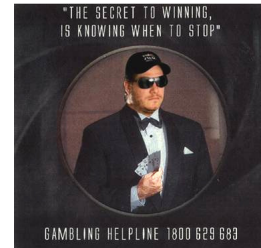

HOT PIES – COLLINGWOOD LIFTS THE LID!



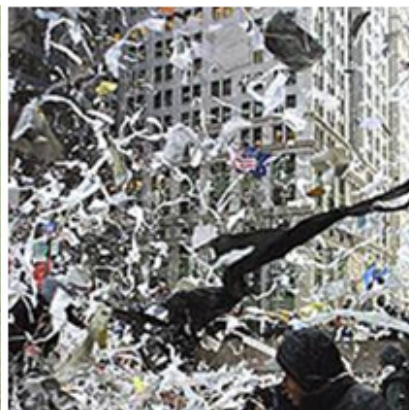
Well it is official...the Pies are now 2010 AFL Premiership favourites and the lid...which the Pies had been publicly trying to keep on...has been blown clean off!

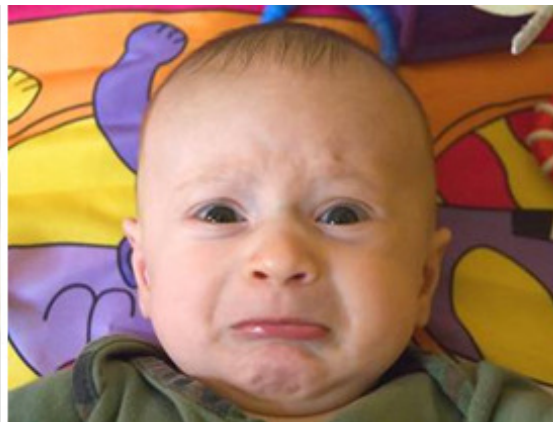
