THE BALD ARCHYS – "MARVELLOUS!"



The **Bald Archys**. No, this is *not* a reference to **Sam Gibson**'s hair line...but rather to an Australian art prize, a parody of the more austere (snooty) and revered portraiture award, the **Archibald Prize**.

It usually includes cartoons or humorous works making fun of Australian celebrities. The Bald Archy Prize was founded in 1994 in a small village named Coolac (outside Gundagai) in New South Wales, by experienced arts administrator and successful theatre director, **Peter Batey OAM**, as part of an arts festival named the **Coolac Festival of Fun**, to avoid discrimination by those afraid of a cultural image.

The absurdity of judging art is highlighted even more by the organiser's assertion that the Bald Archy Prize winner is chosen by a sulphur-crested cockatoo named **Maude**, a cockatoo (*pictured repeatedly above*), who claims she is as qualified as any other judge in the land! Now how can you argue with that!

The 2011 winner of the Bald Archy was French artist **Xavier Ghazi**, with his caricature of Wiki leaker **Julian Assange**, called "*Bass Ass-Ange*". Ghazi said he chose Mr Assange because he agreed with the 'philosophy' behind WikiLeaks. We're not entirely certain what that means.
